Sue-Ellen Brook (QLD)



Suellen has ridden and competed with horses since she was 5yo. She currently works professionally with horses running an Equine Assisted Learning and Equine Assisted Therapy business full time on the Sunshine Coast. Queensland.

Suellen is the current President of the Australian Hunter and Show Horse Association, if which she is a National Panel Judge. She is also a National Panel Judge of Dilutes Australia and an EA Show Horse State Panel Judge. Her experience in judging is known for her knowledge of show horses/ hacks, as well as her fairness and being "just "to all competitors under her watchful eye.

She has successfully achieved 36 NATIONAL titles with her Palomino Show Hunter Hack. This also includes numerous Supreme Open Show Hunter Hacks, including Side Saddle at Agricultural Shows, placing Top 3 at SHC Open Show Hunter HOTY Qld, Dilute Supremes at Royal Shows — Canberra, Brisbane and Sydney; led and ridden.

Suellen has judged at Canberra Royal Show, Qld Youngstock Shows and Qld Dilute Shows. She has also judged a number of EA Hack Shows in Qld Not only has Suellen competed, but she has also been on the "organisers side", being Ringmaster and organiser for State and Regional Shows. She is passionate about the Show Horses, as well as being professional in her role of show horse judge. Suellen is looking forward to her next chapter with her beautiful warmblood filly who will be started under saddle later this year.

Marjorie Radford lives in a very pretty area of Cardup in Western Australia.






Walk out through centre away from judge, pick up trot, half circle right, trot along the long side, pick-up canter on right rein in the corner, canter half circle right and simple change onto the left rein. Canter half a circle left and hand gallop down the long side. Come back to working canter, back through the transitions to trot and then walk, halt in front of the judge.

Open Newcomer Classes




Walk out to the right and pick-up trot, two loop serpentine, lengthen trot along the long side, back to working trot.

Pickup canter on the right rein, canter half a circle right, simple change onto the left rein, canter half circle left, back through the transitions to trot and then walk, halt in front of the judge.

Preliminary and Owner Rider Open Classes




Walk out to the left and pick-up trot, continue trot across the diagonal lengthen trot and pickup canter on the left rein in the corner. Canter half a circle left and change onto the right rein. Canter half a circle right and lengthen canter down the long side. Come back to working canter, along the long side back to trot, through to walk and halt in front of judge.

Preliminary and Owner Rider Show Hunter Classes




Walk out to the left and pick-up trot, half circle right, change rein, half circle left. Pickup canter on the left rein in the corner. Canter half a circle left and change onto the right rein. Canter half a circle right and lengthen canter down the long side. Come back to working canter, along the long side back to trot, through to walk and halt in front of judge.




Enter at working TROT

Track right and half circle working TROT RIGHT rein, Pick up CANTER left, half circle left,


LENGTHEN CANTER along long side, back to working canter, half circle left. Change rein, CANTER half circle right.




Leave line up on . left rein down long side.




Leave Line up at working trot on left rein down long side.

Rider 5years and under 9 years Rider 9, 10 & 11 years




Enter at sitting trot only the long side, start rising trot in the corner, track right and rising trot half circle right. Change rein and rising trot half circle left. Pick up canter left and canter half a circle, simple change and Canter half a circle right. Back to trot and along the long side rising trot out and leave arena.


Rider 12, 13 & 14 years Rider 15, 16 & 17 years



Enter at sitting trot across the diagonal, track left and start rising trot in the corner, half circle left rising trot. In the centre, pick up canter left and left circle at the canter. Change rein (optional change) and canter right half circle, lengthen canter along the long side and back to working canter before the corner, back to rising trot around the arena and exit along the long side rising trot out of the arena.

Enter rising trot down the long and track right continue in rising trot. Change rein across the diagonal sitting lengthen trot. Track left, sit trot along the short side and pick up canter left in corner. Canter left along the long side, turn left and half circle left. Working Canter half circle righ and into lengthen canter along the long side, back to canter and then rising trot along short side and exit at working trot either sitting or rising.
