BARE Equestrian NSW Horse of the Year

Welcome to the BARE Equestrian NSW Horse of the Year 2023. These Rider Notes will provide some detailed information on the upcoming event. Please read them thoroughly.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

Arrivals are from 10am to 7pm on 13/9 or 6am to 6pm from Thursday 14/9. Gates to SIEC are closed until 6am. Please only unload in the designated unloading bay. The Stable Warden will be available to unlock your stable on arrival.

CAMPING

Please camp in the spot allocated to you. Anyone parked in the incorrect spot will be asked to move.

STABLES

The Stable Manager for the event, **Nick Mougios**, will need to unlock your stable on arrival. Nick can be found around the stable area or contacted on **0416 138 639 between 6:00am & 6:00pm ONLY**. You will need to bring everything your horse will need including water buckets and feed buckets.

Each stable booking includes 4 bales of shavings. If you have ordered extra bales, they will be in your stable on arrival. Extra bales can also be purchased at the Event Office.

To have your stable bond returned, you will need to clean and sweep out your stable and have it checked and marked off by the Stable Manager. Limited cleaning equipment is available at SIEC, it is recommended you please bring your own wheelbarrow, rake, shovel and broom.

EVENT OFFICE

Due to the large number of horses entered presentation will be done away from the ring to allow the next class to commence. Horses must be mounted for presentation. Exhibits must compete in catalogued order.

ARENA ACCESS

Thursday: At the completion of the Thursday classes.

Friday: 6am-7am (Only for horses entered in the Childs classes to be ridden only by the entered child rider.)

Sat & Sun: 6am-6:45am – Leading Rein 6:45am-7am.

There will be a section of the Main Arena open all day to competitors.

Arena 2 will be open as a general work arena.
