FASHION APPROPRIATENESS FOR THE EVENT Score out of 25 OVERALL STYLE, GROOMING & PRESENTATION Score out of 25

ATTENTION TO DETAIL (MILLINERY, CLUTCH, JEWELLERY) Score out of 25

No Led workout will be conducted - During the horse scoring phase the horse will present to the judge for viewing.

PLACINGS

Top 5 Runner Up Winner

SECTIONS FOR ENTRY

- Under 18 years
- 18-29 years
- 30 years and over

CLOTHING RULES

- The style, originality and suitability of the outfit should be appropriate for attending a racing carnival
- Narrow shoulder straps and strapless clothing are strongly discouraged
- Millinery (hats & fascinators) are encouraged
- The elements of your outfit should complement the horse
- Closed footwear must be worn at all times.

Note: Horses are permitted to have a handler who must also wear closed toe shoes & be dressed appropriately for FOTF.

ENTRANT RULES

FOTF is open to any person attending the event who has purchased a Friday entry wristband - this includes competitors, owners and grooms etc.

HORSE RULES

- The horse must be entered in the 2022 EA Nationals
- Horses can only be used for 1 entrant per class but may enter more than one age group.
